Incident: Auto Theft
Possession of a stolen auto
Under the influence of a controlled substance

Date/Time: January 1, 2012, 9:23 A.M.

Location: 600 block of S. Jaye Street, Porterville

Suspect: Johnny Navarrete, 30 years, Porterville resident
Teresa Navarro, 20 years, Porterville resident

Narrative:

On January 1, 2012, at 9:23 A.M., Officers of the Porterville Police Department located a reported stolen vehicle that was occupied in the 600 block of S. Jaye Street. Officers initiated a traffic stop on the stolen vehicle and detained two subjects, identified as 30 year old Johnny Navarrete and 20 year old Teresa Navarro. Navarrete was taken into custody for auto theft and possession of a stolen auto. Though Navarro did not have knowledge that the vehicle was stolen she was found to be under the influence of a controlled substance. She was subsequently arrested for the narcotic violation.

Navarrete was booked into the custody of the Tulare County Sheriffs Office for auto theft and possession of a stolen auto. Navarro was issued a citation for being under the influence of a controlled substance. This case remains under investigation.
