### **Summary:**

On December 9, 2011, at about 12:10 AM, Officers of the Porterville Police Department responded to Friendly Liquor, 814 W. Olive Avenue, for a report of a potential burglary. As officers arrived two juveniles, one fifteen years old and the other seventeen, were observed running from the area. Both juveniles were caught and detained. The two were ultimately identified by witnesses as the two that attempted to dismantle the business alarm. They were also witnessed throwing a rock through the window. Both juvenile suspects admitted to their role in the crime and stated their goal was to steal alcohol from the business. Both juveniles were booked at Tulare County Juvenile Hall on charges of burglary and conspiracy to commit burglary. This case remains under investigation.
