Incident: Vehicle Burglary
Possession of stolen property
Parole Violation

Location: CVS Pharmacy, 1155 W. Henderson Avenue, Porterville

Suspect(s): Brian Flynn, 39 years, Porterville resident

Narrative:

On December 19, 2011, at approximately 3:19 PM, Porterville Police Officers responded to CVS Pharmacy on Henderson Avenue for a report of a vehicle burglary in progress. Officers arrived on scene and contacted the victim who stated an unknown suspect made entry into her locked vehicle and removed her purse from the passenger area. Officers determined entry into the vehicle had been made from a partially open side window.

Officers were contacted by a witness who stated he observed a white male adult make entry into the vehicle and remove the purse. The witness confronted the suspect who fled on foot through a field south of the business. Officers followed shoe tracks through the open field which led officers to 39 year old Brian Flynn, who was hiding in a fenced area in the 700 block of N. Prospect Street.

Flynn was found to be in possession of the stolen purse and on active California state parole. Flynn was arrested for vehicle burglary, possessing stolen property, and a parole hold was issued by state parole. The stolen property was returned to the victim and Flynn was booked into the Tulare County Jail where he is being held without bail.
